About this opportunity:

You will be supported to complete the Certificate III in Legal Services (BSB30320-01). Your training, travel and associated course costs will be covered for you whilst you are supported to complete your studies. If you are not currently employed, this unique program provides you with the opportunity to apply for a 12 weeks paid employment with Legal Aid NSW.

Successful completion of this qualification and others within the Program may provide a pathway to further legal studies and possible employment (eligibility criteria apply).

About the qualification:

Through a combination of weekly online, virtual theory and face to face training, you will gain foundational skills in legal services. Learn legal terminology, explore how the justice system works, provide trustworthy support, and develop the organisational abilities to take your legal services career anywhere.
