ABOUT THE AWARDS

ELIGIBILITY

- The nominee must be a resident of City West Housing.
- Nominations can be made by any resident or staff of City West Housing. Residents cannot nominate themselves.
- A person cannot win an award in the same category for two consecutive years.
- A person may receive an award in consecutive years if it's in a different category and for a different contribution.
- Unsuccessful nominees may be nominated in future years.
- Nominations must be made on an official nomination form.
- The judging panel may request more information to clarify claims made in an application.

WE'RE LOOKING FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE FOLLOWING FOUR AWARDS

CREATIVE MINDS AWARD

Recognising a CWH resident who has made artistic contributions to their community and inspired others with their work.

LEADERSHIP AWARD

Recognising a CWH resident who has shown leadership in their community.

COMMUNITY HERO AWARD

This award recognises a CWH resident who has been active in and contributed positively to others in their building or the broader community. This could be through organsing an event or project, or simply reaching out to neighbours who need help.

THE WINNER OF EACH AWARD WILL RECEIVE A \$1250 COLES GROUP & MYER VOUCHER THAT CAN BE USED AT ANY STORE IN AUSTRALIA

OUTSTANDING YOUNG PERSON AWARD

Recognising a CWH resident, who is 25 years or under, who has overcome barriers to achieve their goals. This can include academic, sports, arts, culture and musical achievements.

NOMINATIONS AND JUDGING

- Nominations for all awards will be reviewed by a judging panel consisting of City West Housing staff. Residents are not eligible to sit on the panel
- We propose to award a winner in each category and may award a runner up prize, depending on the nominations received
- The judges' decisions will be final.

TIMELINE

- Nominations now open, closing 15 September
- Finalists will be contacted in early October
- The winners will be announced at the Annual Resident Forum on 18 October 2025.
